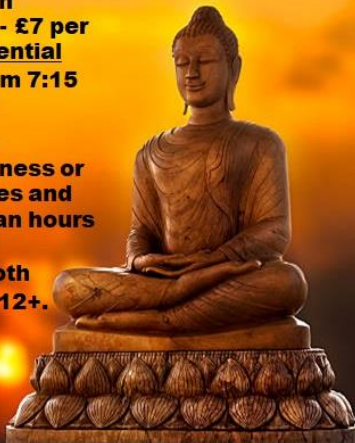
MiYoga classes are:
